- **Bedside Violence Intervention** – Jenny Vargus introduced this topic in July. The School of Public Health is looking at this program for a research project. Current interest involves laser tattoo removal

New Business:

- **Membership Updates** – An update of paid memberships (6) was provided. There have been 2 individual memberships received.

Committee Reports:

- **Injury Prevention**
 - CMH participated in the Sprint Family Fun weekend in the Power and Light District
 - KU worked in Salina with concussion screening guidelines and helped with training in the community and sideline coaching screening. A PowerPoint presentation was given as well as screening forms provided.
 - TMC participated in the Touchdown Family Fest (7/16/11) at Arrowhead Stadium and the National Night Out Against Crime (8/2/11) at Swope Parkway. Injury prevention information was provided.
 - An event was provided at the KS Speedway drilling military first aid.
- **MARCER** – Carolyn Wells provided some information about the current state of the EM system. She is working with the vendor to provide a more friendly system. There will be a collaboration between the vendor/ MHA/ MARCER.
- **Region A** - The next meeting is at Kearney Fire on August 8th at 1300.

- **SAC** – The meeting was held in Branson. There has been some concern about entities providing instruction for paramedics. There is a December 2012 deadline and it takes 12-18 months to become a certified entity. The expectation is that there will be a shortage of programs in MO.
- **NE Region** – There was a review of Joplin victims distributed. Regional PI passed through legislation. There was a state advisory meeting in Wichita with an expectation to have a couple of concurrent data points. There was a presentation on how to route research to the SE corner of the state.
- **Legislature** – Not in session. Information – Kansas Peer Review protection was approved for regional PI
