### Committee Reports:

**Injury Prevention:** MTS has inquired as to the feasibility of doing a billboard for injury prevention. Cost ranges from \$1500 - \$5000 for downtown. There is a city proclamation for trauma month.

Jenny reports that there has been little movement with the Concussion Coalition due to the swimming addendum pertaining to high school swimming athletes. It was passed in the Senate. The House recommends to remove the swimming piece. In May, NKC hospital is doing an internal no texting campaign with thumb rings. TMC is doing an internal and external IPF at the hospital and at the City Market on 5/13/11. Bill Cosby was at the Ruskin High School with Dr. Moncure for a "scared straight" presentation with a 30 minute session with 15 kids.

Sprint is having a family fun series from May through October and expects 7-10,000. CMH is having an IP booth.

**MARCER:** The revised ambulance diversion is to include TCD. It is not in effect until approved and there needs to be lead time for ED education.

**SAC:** The group hopes to have final documents by May with meetings scheduled April 21<sup>st</sup> and May 3<sup>rd</sup> in Jefferson City. The Pediatric subcommittee met and 330 attended the conference. They are concerned about EMSC grant. Greg Natsch and Margaret Connelly will be in all meetings and on calls. Dr. Muzafur is reviewing the helicopter utilization guidelines.

**Region A:** The next meeting is May 2 at John Knox Village. The EMS group has received a grant to provide 120,000 laptops for ambulance services. There is a need to bridge from the field to access the information. Image Trend has offered to build an electronic format.

**NE Region:** The state meeting is on April 18 on public health as the topic.
