The initial challenge when caring for the trauma patient is based on the "ABC's of Resuscitation." Unfortunately, despite our best efforts, a significant number of critically injured patients will progress to develop trauma-related complications. The health care provider's ability to accurately interpret assessment findings and provide appropriate interventions is the key to survival for the patient experiencing the complications of trauma.

- OBJECTIVES**
- Identify complications typical of the critically injured trauma patient.
  - List assessment priorities based on the system specific complications presented.
  - Describe appropriate interventions for patients experiencing trauma-related complications.
